

Lt Col William P. Mueller, M.D. (Bill) is a board-certified Family Physician in the United States Air Force. He graduated from the United States Air Force Academy in 1987 where he received a Bachelor of Science degree in Astronautical Engineering. He began his Air Force career as a pilot, and has been an aircraft commander and instructor pilot in the RF-4C, T-37, B-1B, and T-38 aircraft.
